




OUTDOOR EDUCATION PROSPECTUS 2019




Our programmes specialise in personal and social development, teamwork, leadership and relationships with others. Adventure becomes the medium for students to explore their strengths and realise their capabilities.

Dunstan High School shares management of Tititea Lodge, located in the East Matukituki Valley on the outskirts of Mount Aspiring National Park. The school runs a number of camps from Tititea each year.



The senior Outdoor Education courses offer opportunities to gain credits towards the New Zealand National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) qualifications.



Even though Dunstan High School is set in the unique landscapes of the distant South of New Zealand, it is surprisingly easy to reach. There are regular international flights to both Auckland and Christchurch, and then onward regular domestic flights to and from Queenstown.

Queenstown is a 70min drive from Alexandra and a pick-up service can be arranged by the school.
