



School Animation Competition

Have you got what it takes to animate???

Make a stop-motion animation using LEGO

Open to all schools in the Otago region.

- 3 categories: primary, intermediate & secondary schools.
- Teams of up to 6 students.
- Animations need to be 2 minutes or less.
- LEGO must be used for all moving parts & some scenery.
- Backgrounds and bases can be generic: painted, montage, etc.
- Entries close on Friday September 27th.
- Full details and rules attached.

Animation Competition Rules

* This competition is open to all schools in the Otago region.

* There are 3 categories

- Primary - years 3-6
- Intermediate - years 7-8
- Secondary - years 9-13

(We will allow entries from small full-primary schools with mixed years, eg: a class with years 6, 7, 8 to enter a team in one of the categories.)

* Create a LEGO stop-motion movie showing us why your school is the BEST. Your school could have the best playground, science room, school trip, building or even principal. Use your imagination and have fun. The animation can be up to 2 minutes long.

Here is an example of a stop-motion animation from a previous show or check out some of the amazing LEGO animations on Youtube.

* All the moving parts plus the majority of the setting must be made from LEGO.

The background and base can be generic. Eg: Teams may decide to paint the main scene and then add LEGO trees, buildings or vehicles.

* Each school can enter up to two animations for each category: Primary, Intermediate or Secondary school, so choose your best animations. Teams can be up to 6 students.

* Register by sending your team names to brickshowcomp@gmail.com (members and team names can be updated prior to video submission).

* **Entries close on September 27th 2024.**

* Upload entries to Youtube as an UNLISTED video and email a sharable link to brickshowcomp@gmail.com on or before this date. A dropbox/google drive link can be provided as well for your entry. Email brickshowcomp@gmail.com for a link.

* The winning schools will be announced at the Dunedin Brick Show on Sunday October 6th.

* The judges decision is final.

Prizes: Your school could win one of the brick trophies, plus LEGO prizes and consolation prizes.

Throughout the weekend of the Dunedin Brick Show, the animations will be screened so make sure you come along.
