Season Information:

Trials: There are no trials for Canoe polo. We welcome anyone who is interested in the sport to join the training sessions and play in the local Canoe Polo competition on Tuesday and Thursday evening at the Molyneux Aquatic Centre.

Trainings: The school works very closely with the Central Otago Whitewater Club. Introductory sessions are run by the club on a Tuesday evening in terms 2 and 3. For school representative teams there is specific training and selection.

Games: Held in terms 2 and 3 on Tuesday and Thursday evening depending on the grade that is being played.

Exchanges and Tournaments: SISS event held during term 3

Cost: Approx. \$70/term for pool entry and lane hire for competition. Approx. \$300 for SISS tournament

Uniforms: School rash tops to compete in supplied.

Equipment Required: Equipment is supplied. Boat, vest, helmet and paddle. If students are going to develop the sport further they are encouraged to build up their own kit.

Canoe polo provides the perfect skills development to river kayaking in a very safe and comfortable environment. We encourage all those looking to river kayak to use this as a progression to the open water paddling.
